

HOW TO GET RID OF LOBBYING

Committeemen can pressure NY Legislatures to

- (1) Out law the lobbying of all NY candidates
- (2) Write legislation to breakup the news media cartels in New York and
- (3) Enforce the media's duty to provide free unbiased equal air time for all candidates running for any political office during the election race, after all this is the most important news we should be hearing.

30 second commercials and campaign signs that expect to inform people of a candidate are an insult to the American People and should be discouraged

The Committeemen in their respective towns should post signs at strategic intersections advertising the upcoming election and where people can view detailed information on the candidates, and not signs for candidates.

Every polling place upon its information table should (1) list all vacancies being filled (2) define the duties of the candidate to fill the vacancy (3) List all the candidates and provide a one page 500 word essay written by each candidate telling us why we should vote for them. This information should be posted on the NYSBOE's website at least 60 days before the primary election and updated after the primary election.

The Committeemen have a duty to fill vacancies and to provide people with intelligent information on the candidates that we are supporting. Equal time/space should be given to all candidates on our website with links to the candidate's web sites.

Candidates should not have to have money to run for office they should need only to file a designating petition and provide us and the BOE with the necessary information concerning their positions. If the committeemen don't support their run and the candidate is unable to get people to help walk their petitions then the people have spoken.

Candidates should not need money to run for office, and they certainly shouldn't be taken "bribes" from lobbyists.

There is absolutely no reason for committeemen to involve themselves in or incite partisan politics, none! Why would we want to make any issue political our job is to fill vacancies and educating the people in the candidates that we offer and if groups of people want to get political that's their business.

This is not complicated, don't believe these progressives that you need such a complicated system and that you need "political" parties when you only need informative parties after all you are voting for your representatives whereas the "political party view" ends up with representation for the few who control the will of the party and you already have experienced that it is not you.

Yes! It's that simple!
