Under the Heading list the following that applies!

- Jurisdiction of the court, usually chancery under civil law
- Case disposition: (1 to 4 sentences)
- Clearly list your right violations stating the proper Amendment violated.
- Were you denied the right of Habeas Corpus or Writ of error?
- Were you pressured to take a plea or you will receive a long jail sentence?
- Keep it short no story telling remember less is more, just the facts!

Amendment IV The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated, and no Warrants shall issue, but upon probable cause, supported by Oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched, and the persons or things to be seized.

- Was there searches and seizures without a warrant supported by Oath or affirmation and description describing the place to be searched, and the persons or things to be seized?

Amendment V No person shall be held to answer for a capital, or otherwise infamous crime, unless on a presentment or indictment of a Grand Jury, except in cases arising in the land or naval forces, or in the Militia, when in actual service in time of War or public danger; nor shall any person be subject for the same offence to be twice put in jeopardy of life or limb; nor shall be compelled in any criminal case to be a witness against himself, nor be deprived of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law; nor shall private property be taken for public use, without just compensation.

If criminal case

- Was there a "Grand Jury indictment?"
- Was there a free and independent trial by jury?
- Double jeopardy?
- Were you deprived of liberty or property without due process of law?

Amendment VI In all criminal prosecutions, the accused shall enjoy the right to a speedy and public trial, by an impartial jury of the State and district wherein the crime shall have been committed, which district shall have been previously ascertained by law, and to be informed of the nature and cause of the accusation; to be confronted with the witnesses against him; to have compulsory process for obtaining witnesses in his favor, and to have the Assistance of Counsel for his defense.

- Were you deprived a trial by an impartial jury? Get a copy of jury questionnaire?
- Did the judge deny any evidence or witnesses on your behalf
- Did you get Assistance of Counsel under your control and not the judge?

Amendment VII In suits at common law, where the value in controversy shall exceed twenty dollars, the right of trial by jury shall be preserved, and no fact tried by a jury, shall be otherwise reexamined in any Court of the United States, then according to the rules of the common law.

- Were you denied a trial by jury orientated in the common law?
- If you appealed was the process under the common law?

Amendment VIII Excessive bail shall not be required, nor excessive fines imposed, nor cruel and unusual punishments inflicted.

- Were excessive bail or fines imposed?
- Were cruel and unusual punishments inflicted?
